## Pull Out Kitchen Mixer Instruction Card

- 1) Ensure you have a minimum of 550mm vertical clearance under the hob, to accommodate the pull out hose system.
- 2) Make sure that all lines have been properly flushed. Ensure that the static water pressure does not exceed 500kpa, as per AS3500. If pressure exceeds this, install Pressure Limiting Valves. Failure to do so will void the warranty.
- 3) Ensure that the hole size in the bench / hob is 35mm in diameter. Keep in mind that the maximum pull out reach is 345mm.
- 4) Remove the Mounting Nut and Washer from the mixer assembly. Remove the Counter Weight off the pull out hose.
- 5) Slide mixer through the top side of the bench / hob. Refit and tighten Mounting Nut and Washer to the under side of the bench Hob.
- 6) Check and test the pull out hose, and ensure that it can be pulled out freely and easily, and ensure there are no obstructions to the hoses. Refit the counter weight 385mm from underside of mounting nipple to centre of counter weight.
- 7) Connect the Hot and Cold hoses to the stop cocks (not supplied) under the bench / hob. Tighten the hose connections, then turn them both on.

  8) Chack the miver for general functionality and leaks. Chack that spray has
- 8) Check the mixer for general functionality and leaks. Check that spray head works correctly.
